BEF-Alpha – educational year for adult refugees provides support with

- the development of language skills
- the vocational orientation for admission to the training or labour market, etc. via internships
- the learning of important basic cultural and social factors in Germany, particularly with regard to women and social minorities, as well as basic political education

Target group: Refugees between the ages of 21 and 35 years – in exceptional cases also older – with little or no written and language skills (illiterate or functionally illiterate)

BPJ BW – practical vocational year Baden-Württemberg

- helps with the search for a training place
- provides an introductory qualification (EQ)
- offers lessons and socio-educational support to improve German language skills, basic knowledge and efforts to apply for jobs
- provides socio-educational support and assistance

Target group in Heidelberg: Young people under the age of 25 that are assigned by the *Jobcenter Rhein-Neckar-Kreis* and by the *Jobcenter Heidelberg*.

Target group in Mannheim: Young people under the age of 25 that are assigned by the *Jobcenter Mannheim* or the *Agentur für Arbeit Mannheim*.

- Vocational orientation with a focus on the "skilled trades"
- Employability and training skills are acquired through the attainment of key occupational skills
- The acquisition of basic manual skills in one of the following areas: horticulture, bakery, metalworking, carpentry, painting
